

Union Aquatic Club (UNAC) Privacy and Website Security Policy

Policy Overview

The Union Aquatic Club is committed to protecting the privacy and security of visitors to our website and also committed to protecting the privacy and security of our swimmers and the swimmer information that is posted on our website. Outlined below is our online privacy policy for information collected through our website, all swimmer information posted on our website, and email lists collected by the club. If you have any questions about these policies, we encourage you to discuss them with us by contacting a board member.

Resale/disclosure of information to third parties:

We do not share or otherwise disclose any personal information, including your name, address and e-mail address, with organizations outside of the Union Aquatic Club, Niagara Swimming or USA Swimming. Only Union Aquatics board members and coaches have access to personally identifying information provided by visitors to our site. We do not exchange, trade, rent, or give e-mail lists to third parties. The Club (UNAC) will only send e-mails to swimmers, coaches and staff related to Union Aquatic Club activities.

Browser information collected on our website:

As with most website operators, the Union Aquatic Club webmaster analyzes our website logs to improve the value of our website. We use a service to provide real-time reporting to us of browser accesses to our site, including page views, unique views, unique visitors, repeat visitors, frequency of visits, and peak-volume traffic periods. We do not use this service to gather, request, record, require, collect or track any Internet users' personally identifying information.

Privacy of our email lists:

Union Aquatic Club maintains a separate e-mail list to keep Swimmers, Coaches, and Board Members up to date on League/Club issues and activities only. Individuals must request or authorize their e-mail address to be added to our e-mailing lists. In addition, we do not share the e-mail addresses on our lists with any outside organizations.

Children's privacy:

Because we care about the safety and privacy of children online, we comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA). COPPA and its accompanying FTC regulation establish United States federal law that protects the privacy of children using the Internet. We do not knowingly utilize this website to collect contact or personal information from children under 13. Our site is not intended to solicit information of any kind from children under 13. Parental permission and written consent is required and secured in connection with the provision, posting and maintenance of personally identifying information about swimmers. It is possible that by fraud or deception by others we may receive information given to us by children under 13. If we are notified of this, as soon as we verify the information, we will immediately obtain parental consent or otherwise delete the information from our servers.
